Weisenberg Volunteer Fire Department Comments

Justin Oswald, Fire Chief, informed the Board that they ran 32 calls for the month of July 2026. He reviewed the Fire Department's comment letter dated 8/10/2026 regarding the activity of the fire department for the month of July and upcoming events, grants and membership. Cetronia EMS also provided their call volume for July 2026. The 20th anniversary of the fire department went really well. The new cascade unit will be coming next week. Bylaws and SOG's are going to be paused until a future date.

Weisenberg Community Center – Advisory Committee Comments

Conestoga Buildings - Payment App#13

Motion made by Richard Bleiler, seconded by Antony Werley to approve the payment release of \$33,003.00 for the final work performed by Conestoga Buildings. Brian will hold off the payment until the end of the week to have the final punch list completed. Motion carried. 3-0

The open house event was a huge success, and we had a great turnout of vendors and residents.

Final payment for the turf area will also be held until Brian has confirmed the punch list on that is completed.

Future Events / Users

A meeting will be held with all the directors and coaches of NYAA on Thursday the 28th regarding scheduling. The turf will be open to general membership on Thursdays & Sundays and NYAA can schedule Monday Tuesday Wednesday Friday evenings and Saturdays. The Board realizes this is an ongoing conversation they will be having regarding scheduling and they will monitor the needs of residents and sports together. Brian is looking at netting the walking trail surrounding the turf area so that residents will still be able to walk the perimeter of the turf area. NYAA is also interested in installing a batting cage in the turf area (retractable or installed onto the ceiling) and they would be responsible for the cost of the unit. The Board agreed to rent half the turf out during the AM hours Monday thru Friday.

EAC Comments

Marty stated the car show had about 43 cars, music and vendors. He received a lot of positive feedback and the car show was a huge success. Resident (Trish Knoblauch – 4587 Loch Valley Road) was a tremendous help and will be voted into the EAC for membership.

Roadmaster's Comments

Anthony Werley informed the Board that they are continuing with shoulder mowing grass and working at the community center. They completed oil & chipping projects for Heidelberg and Lynn Township. The line painting of our Township roads was completed. They raked the ball field and replaced a pipe on Blacksmith Road. Wednesday and Thursday they will be at the Northwestern Lehigh Rec Fields to help set up Night in the Country and then tear down on Monday.

Jeff Stauss informed the Board on the Wickett balance of expenses. We have (2) CD's up for renewal.

- 1.) Capital Funds Project - \$300,179.91- Motion was made by Anthony Werley, seconded by Richard Bleiler to renew this CD for another 6 months. Motion carried 3-0
- 2.) General Fund - \$775,123.20 – Motion was made by Anthony Werley, seconded by Richard Bleiler to renew this CD for another 13 months. Motion carried. 3-0

Jeff Strauss informed Anthony Werley (Roadmaster) of the balance (approx. \$294,000.00) of available funds for the year 2026. Jeff also informed the Board that he has one resident on Hailey Court that incurred a late fee.

Jeff also informed the Board the current numbers regarding the Community Center to date:

Donations = \$2,232,100.00

Interest + 65,534.00

\$2,297,634.00

Expenses - \$2,508,087.00

\$210,453.00 – Township Funds

Jeff has entered into the EZfacility program 90 seniors and 45 family memberships that joined at Open House. Janet will spend the time issuing the key fobs for the memberships that have been confirmed paid. Jeff Strauss is having concerns with the program and is working with EZfacility support in order to correct some of the issues in order for them to be resolved.

Motion made by Richard Bleiler, seconded by Anthony Werley to approve \$100,000.00 to be transferred out of the Fire Tax Fund and into the Weisenberg Township Fire Department account for operating expenses. Motion carried. 3-0
